

Rocky Bayou Christian School (RBCS) Home Study Assistance Program

Thank you for your interest in our Home Study Assistance Program. RBCS is dedicated to providing you with the best Christian education services available. These services are explained below. I. Category 1: A full service Home School Umbrella for Grades K-12

This category entitles a home schooling family to be umbrellaed under RBCS and receive a full line of services. These include consultation, curriculum assistance, report cards, transcripts, cumulative folders, annual testing, and a Northwest Florida Christian Education Association (N.F.C.E.A.) Home Study Graduation Diploma. The registration costs for this category are:

K-8 th	\$240	per student
9-11 th	\$300	per student
12 th	\$385	per student

Families registered in this category will also be able to purchase on campus classes, extra curricular activities, athletic programs, and other services offered at RBCS. (For a detailed listing see items A-H below Category 2)

Please note those who register in Category 1 will need to provide the following:

- * The student's birth certificate,
- * DH 3040 Student health evaluation (physical form-Florida Residents only)
- * DH680-Florida Certificate of Immunization
- * A cumulative record including report cards or portfolio or annual testing/evaluation
- * Curriculum List
- * Attendance Records and Quarterly/Semester Grade Reports
- * If 7-12th Grade, a Student Questionnaire, School and Pastoral Reference

II. Category 2: Purchase Individual HSAP Services for Grades K-12

This category provides a home school family the opportunity to purchase individual services such as on-campus classes, athletic programs, and testing. It does not provide an umbrella service. Costs for registration and individual services are listed below.

Registration Cost for	K-12 th	\$35
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A. On-Campus Classes: Our academic program enjoys an excellent reputation and our students have the highest standardized tests scores in Northwest Florida. In order to become a part of our exceptional academic program, you may register for classes from Kindergarten through 12th grade. These classes include, but are not limited too, Bible, Math, Phonics, Language, Spelling, History, Geography, Science and Computer Technology. We also offer Spanish, Latin, Art, P.E. and Music. Our Music Program includes several different levels of Chorus and Band, depending on the student's abilities. Our Music Department competes at both the State and National levels. Our

Academy (7th-12th grade) program also offers Honors Classes in Literature, British Literature, English, the Sciences, Algebra, Geometry, Calculus, Philosophy, and History as well as Advanced Placement Classes for students who are interested in earning college credits. We can also assist for students who request Special Services classes. Costs for classes vary for each grade:

Kindergarten	\$65 per class per month*
1 st -6 th Grades	\$80 per class per month*
7 th -12 th Grades	\$90 per class per month*
Advanced Placement (AP)	\$110 per class per month* plus a \$80 AP Class testing fee
Lab fee for Sciences	\$100 per year

These fees include curriculum for the class purchased. If a student registers for a class in our Special Services Department, there will be an additional charge. Track 3 Classes Grades 1-6 \$110; Grades 7-12 \$160 per class per month Those who purchase classes in Category 2 must purchase either “B” OR “C”:

B. Consultation: \$85 (K-8th) (Cat 2 only)

C. Guidance Services: \$140 (9th-12th) (Cat 2 only)

D. Athletic Programs: We offer a variety of sports to Kindergarten through 12th grade students which include intramural/middle school/junior varsity and varsity basketball, soccer, softball, golf and girl’s volleyball.

K-6 th Intramural Sports	Cost Varies
Middle School	\$65 per sport
JV/Varsity Sports	\$130 per sport

E. Extra Curricular Activities: Cost will depend on activity desired. These activities may include Academic Teams, Science Trips, Math or Academic Competitions. The following clubs may also be available: Art, Beta (for Academic Excellence), Chess, Junior Classical League, Mu Alpha Theta, Missions, NRA, Passion for Purity, Sailing, Spirit, Student Council, and Teen Political Affairs.

F. Annual Testing \$55 (Cat 2 only, testing included in Cat 1)

G. Other Services as requested including Diagnostic Testing: We provide two types of testing. First, we conduct screening for K-1st Graders to identify children who are vulnerable to learning difficulties, which will provide a profile of their strengths and weaknesses in the skills necessary for reading success. The second type is a battery of tests to evaluate children who have been identified by parents, teachers or physicians with difficulty in academics. These tests identify perceptual weaknesses that may be hindering a child’s learning. The cost of testing is determined by the type of test provided.
