Niceville –Four seniors, Josiah Duffey and Aaron Cain from Special Services, and Corrie Sober and Stephanie Serban from the Academy at Rocky Bayou Christian School attended the Twin Cities Auxiliary Luncheon on May 27, 2010. Each student was presented a scholarship ranging from \$500 to \$1,000. There were 20 scholarship recipients with scholarships totaling approximately \$22,000.
