

High School Diploma



Students registered under the RBCS umbrella program will work towards a Northwest Florida Christian Education Association (NFCEA) Home Study Diploma. The NFCEA Diploma requires successful completion of 24 credits in the following subject areas:

- 4 English: major concentration in composition and literature
- 4 Mathematics (one of which must be Algebra 1),
- 3 Science with two labs
- 3 Social Studies (American History, World History, Government ½ credit, Economics ½ credit)
- 4 Bible (1 Bible credit for each year a student is under the umbrella program)
- 1 Physical Education
- 6/5* Electives or more depending on # of Bible credits received

Minimum GPA required 2.0 of a 4.0 scale

All Students must also complete a minimum of 50 hours of Christian Service.

10 hours in 9th Grade

10 hours in 10th Grade

15 hours in 11th Grade

15 hours in 12th Grade
