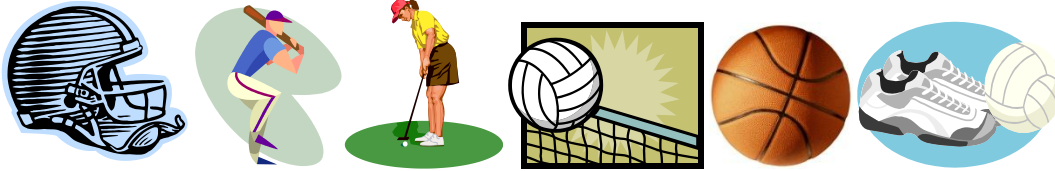


## RBCS Sports Program for Homeschoolers



RBCS offers a variety of sports which homeschoolers may participate in if they meet the eligibility requirements. These sports include football, cross-country, girls' volleyball, basketball, baseball, softball, swimming, tennis, track, weightlifting, and wrestling. In order to participate, you will need to complete the following forms:

**\*RBCS Student Application Form plus \$35.00 registration fee**

**\*Sport's Registration Form (will vary depending on sport) plus fee**

- 1) **Intramural Sports:** Cost varies per sport
- 2) **Middle School Sports:** \$ 65.00
- 3) **JV/Varsity:** \$130.00

### Florida High School Athletic Association Forms

You will also need to complete the following Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) forms:

#### **For those who are registering as CAT 2 (not-umbrelled with RBCS)**

**\*EL 2:** Pre-participation Physical Evaluation

**\*EL 3:** Consent and Release from Liability Certificate

In addition, **For JV/Varsity Sports**

**\*EL 7:** Registration Form for Home Education Student to Participate in Athletic Program at Member School. *This form needs to be notarized.*

*Note: Home schooled students are limited to taking 2 secular courses in order to be eligible for RBCS sports. In addition, a student must show proof of Bible curriculum or register for an RBCS Bible or core class.*

#### **For those who are registering as CAT 1 (umbrelled w/RBCS)**

**\*EL2:** Pre-participation Physical Evaluation

**\*EL3:** Consent and Release from Liability Certificate

**Please turn in ALL forms to the Home School Office, located in the Elementary Bldg**

### ALSO PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING FHSAA REGULATION:

\* IF YOUR HOMESCHOOLED STUDENT IS TAKING MORE THAN THREE ON CAMPUS CLASSES, FHSAA considers them a full time RBCS student/ Category 1 Home Schooler.

\*ANY 6<sup>TH</sup>-12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STUDENT WHO REGISTERS TO PLAY SPORTS WITH RBCS, MAY NOT PLAY SPORTS FOR ANY OTHER FHSAA TEAM IN OUR AREA. TEAMS CAN BE DISQUALIFIED IF INFRACTIONS OCCUR.

\*WHEREVER A STUDENT HAS REGISTERED IN THEIR NINTH GRADE YEAR IS THEIR SCHOOL OF RECORD. IF A STUDENT CHANGES SCHOOLS, THEY MUST SIT OUT A YEAR FROM SPORTS IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY FOR ANOTHER FHSAA SCHOOL.
