

Standardized Testing



California Achievement Test: (Also known as the CAT test). This standardized test is for students finishing K-11th grades and covers the basic areas of Reading, Language and Math. Testing time is approx. 4 hours. This test is offered throughout the year. Cost for an individual test is \$50.00 Group testing is also available between March and August. Cost is \$35 for the group test. Test results are normally available within a week of testing.

Stanford Achievement Testing: (Also known as the SAT test). This standardized test is offered for students finishing K-11th grades as a group test once a year in the spring. This test covers the basics of reading, language and math plus the additional areas of listening, science, social science. There is also a component to test called the Otis Lennon School Ability Test. This is a short test, which shows the student's ability to learn at their current school/age level. This test is offered over a two-day period, 4 hours each day. Cost is \$65 per student. Results of this test take about 6 weeks. **SAT testing dates April 17-18, 2012** Please note we do not offer the **FCAT**.

College Prep Testing

PSAT and PLAN testing: homeschooled students between 9th- 11th grades may also participate in these college preparation tests. The PSAT is a forerunner to the SAT and the PLAN is a forerunner to the ACT. This year the PSAT will be offered Wednesday, Oct 12.

Cost is \$16.00 Time is 8-noon. The PLAN test will be offered Wednesday, Nov 4. Cost is \$13.00 Time is also from 8-noon.
