

High School Diploma

Students who are registered with the RBCS umbrella will work towards a Northwest Florida Christian Education Association (NFCEA) Home Study Diploma. The NFCEA Diploma requires successful completion of 24 credits in the following subject areas:

- 4 English: major concentration in composition and literature
 - *4 Mathematics (one of which must be Algebra 1),
 - 3 Science with two labs
 - 3 Social Studies (American History, World History,
Government ½ credit, Economics ½ credit)
 - 4 Bible (1 Bible credit is required for each year a student is under the RBCS umbrella. For example, if a student enters in their junior year, they will only be required to complete 2 Bible credits.)
 - 1 Physical Education
 - 6/5* Electives or more depending on # of Bible credits received
- *Students entering 9th grade in or after 2007-08 now need 4 math credits

*Please note that if you desire a Bright Futures' Scholarship,
2 of your electives need to be in one Foreign Language*
